Processing Notes

Survey Design: The survey in each country is designed to be nationally representative at the household level. Although certain geographic variables such as province or governorate are provided, the survey is not designed to be representative at sub-national levels.

Weight: The data set includes the weight variable WT. More detailed descriptions of the weight for each country can be found in the technical notes. The weight should be used to produce nationally representative results.

Missing Data: In cases where a questionnaire was completed but the response for a specific question was not marked by the interviewer or is otherwise missing, a code of 0 is applied unless otherwise noted.
