

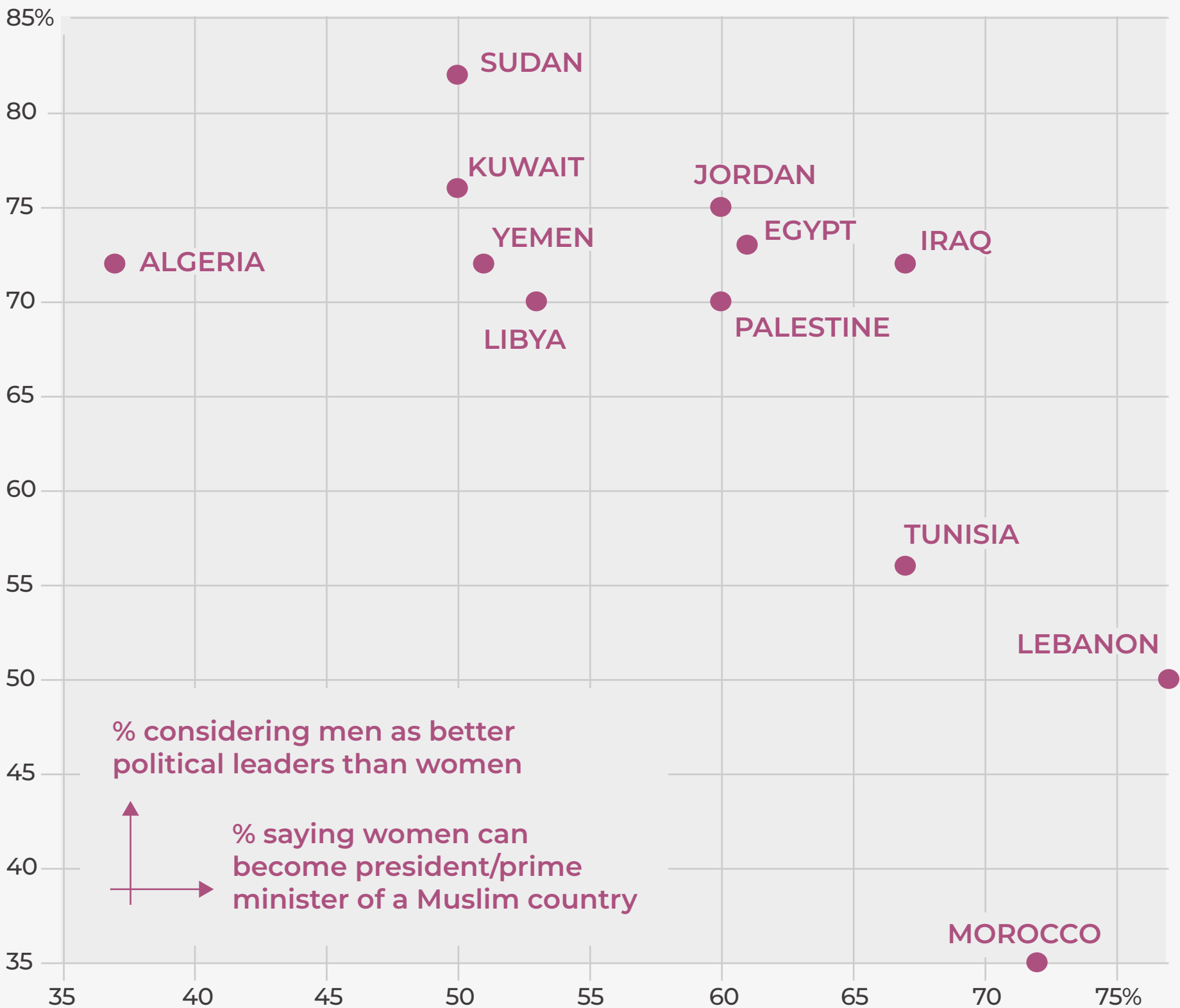
Opinion on Arab women and political power

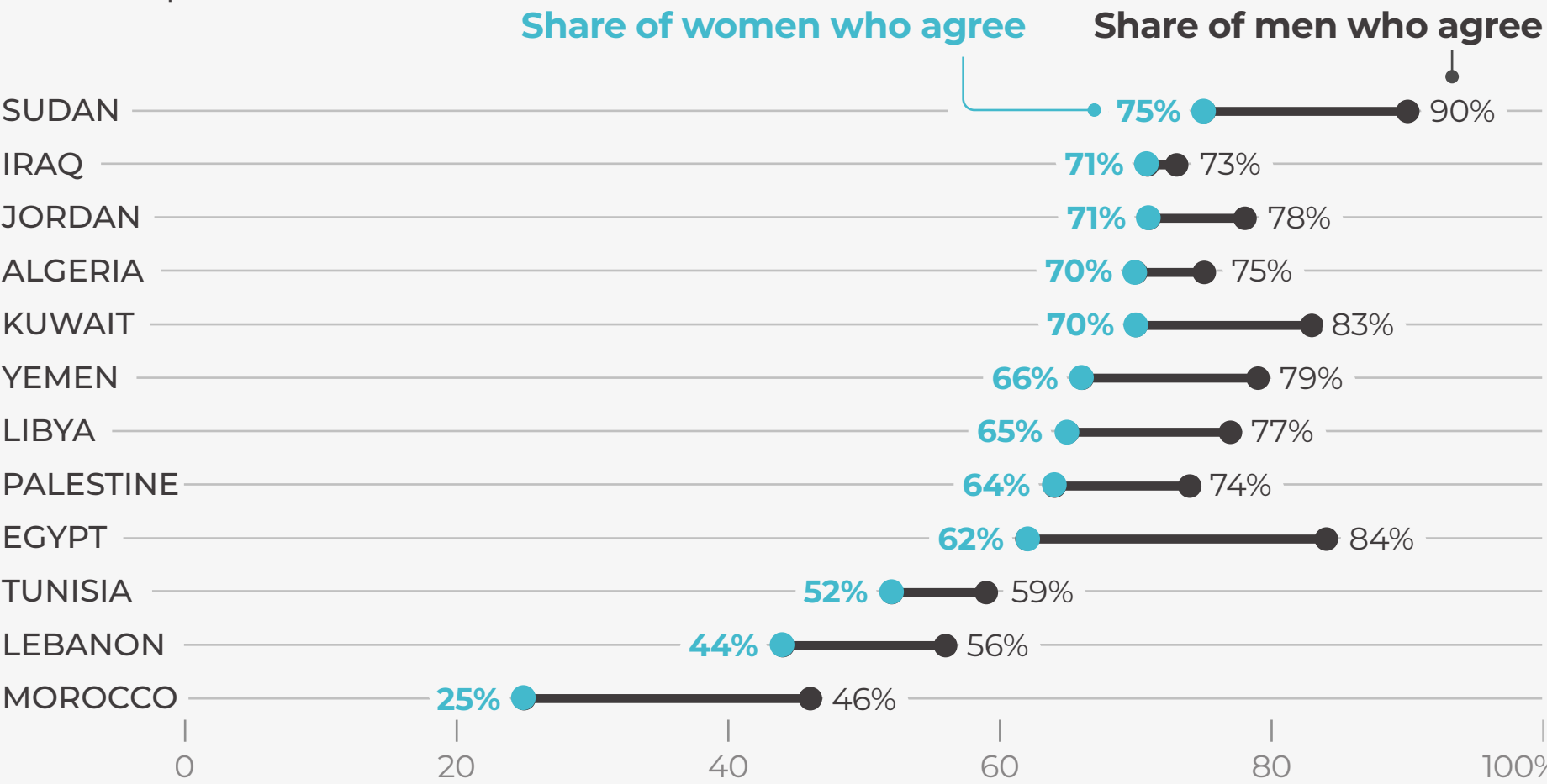
CONSIDERING WOMEN AS POLITICAL LEADERS

Although the majority of citizens in the Arab world think a woman can be head of state, most believe that men are more capable political leaders than women.



MOST WOMEN ARE BIASED AGAINST WOMEN'S LEADERSHIP CAPABILITIES

In 10 of 12 countries more than half of women believe that men are better at political leadership than women.



MAJORITY OF ARAB WOMEN AREN'T INTERESTED IN POLITICS

The gender gap in terms of lack of interest in politics could further hinder women's political participation.
