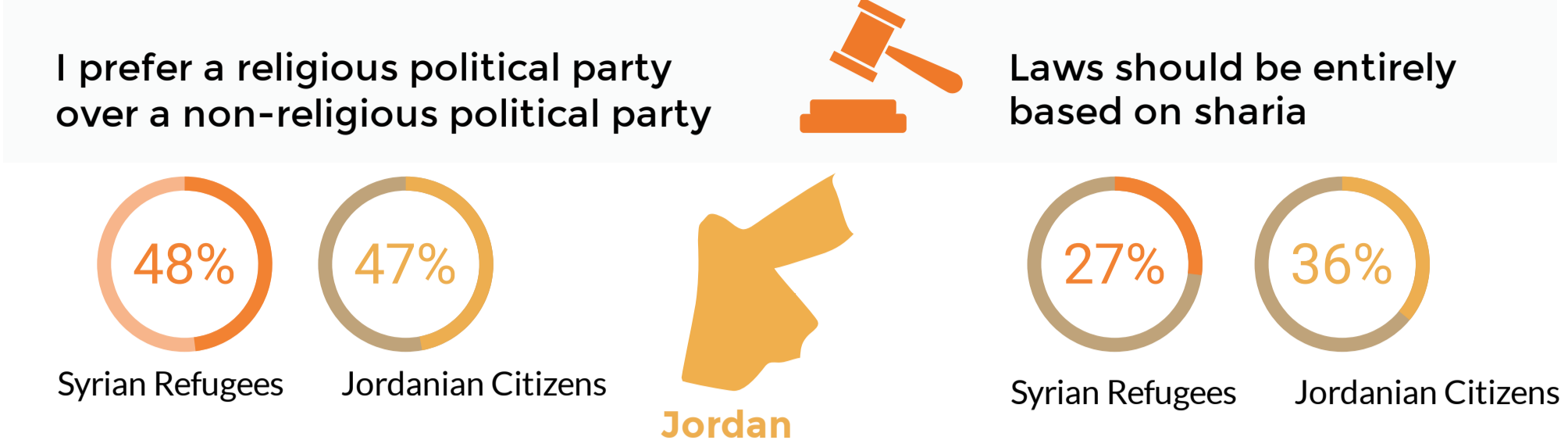


# Syrian Refugees ... Between Lebanon & Jordan

Sample size in each country = 300

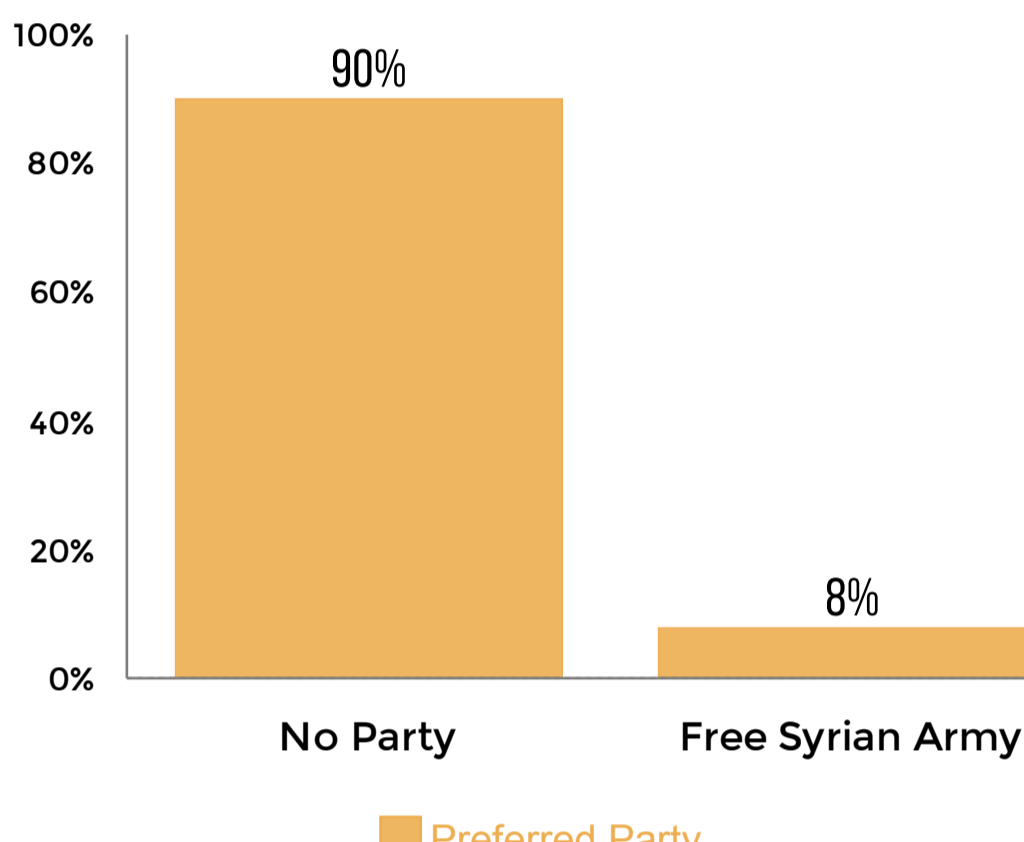
## Similar Views Between Syrian Refugees & Local Residents



## The Preferred Political Party

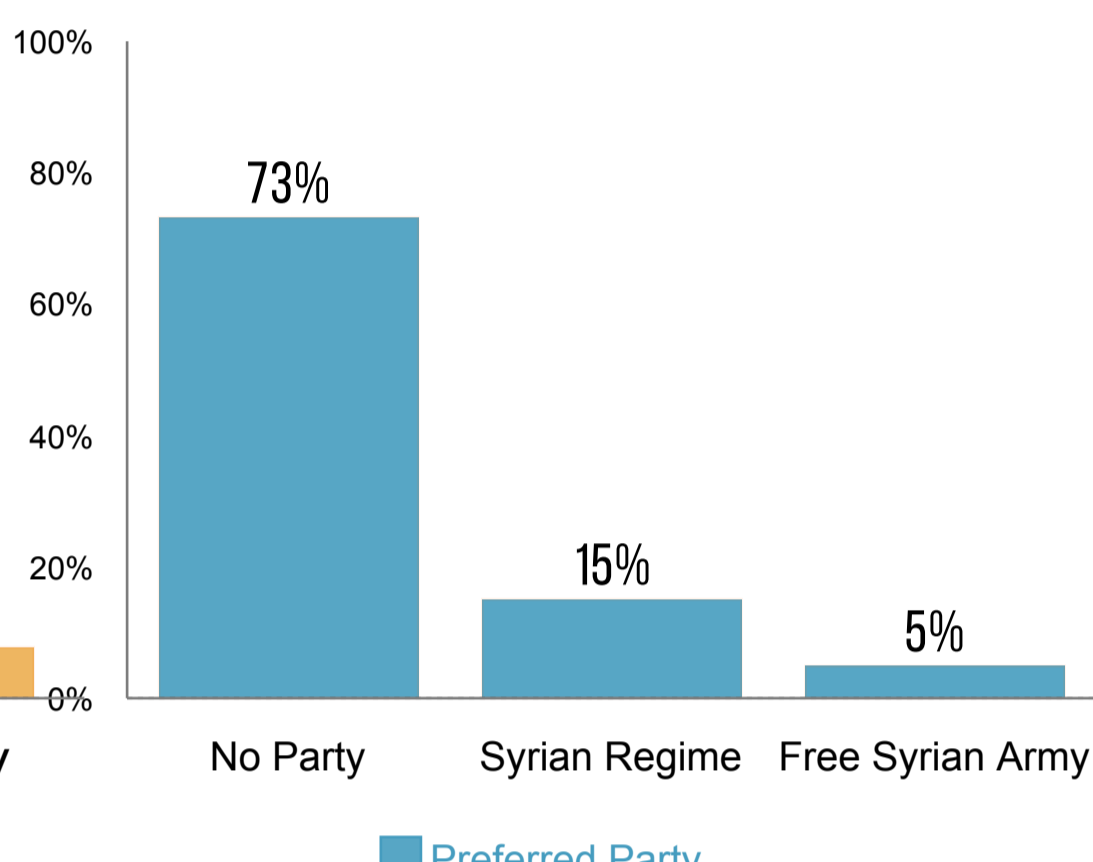
### Syrian Refugees in Jordan

### Syrian Refugees in Lebanon

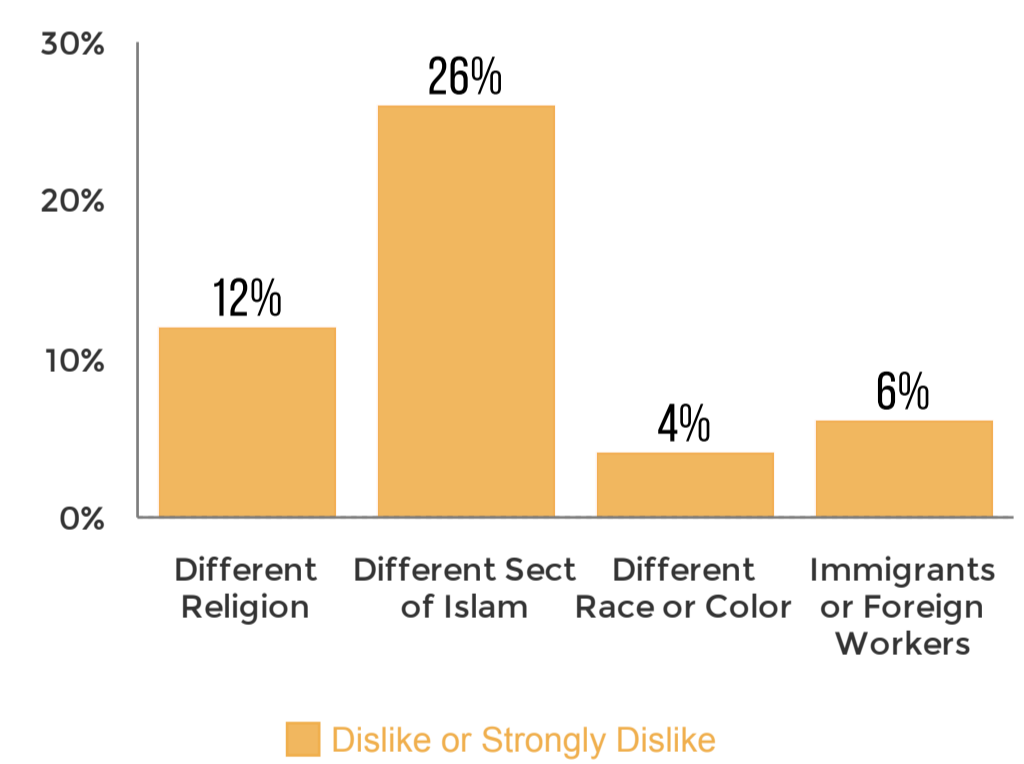
% Syrian Refugees say ... party represent their political, economic & social aspirations



## Neighborhood Preferences & Biases

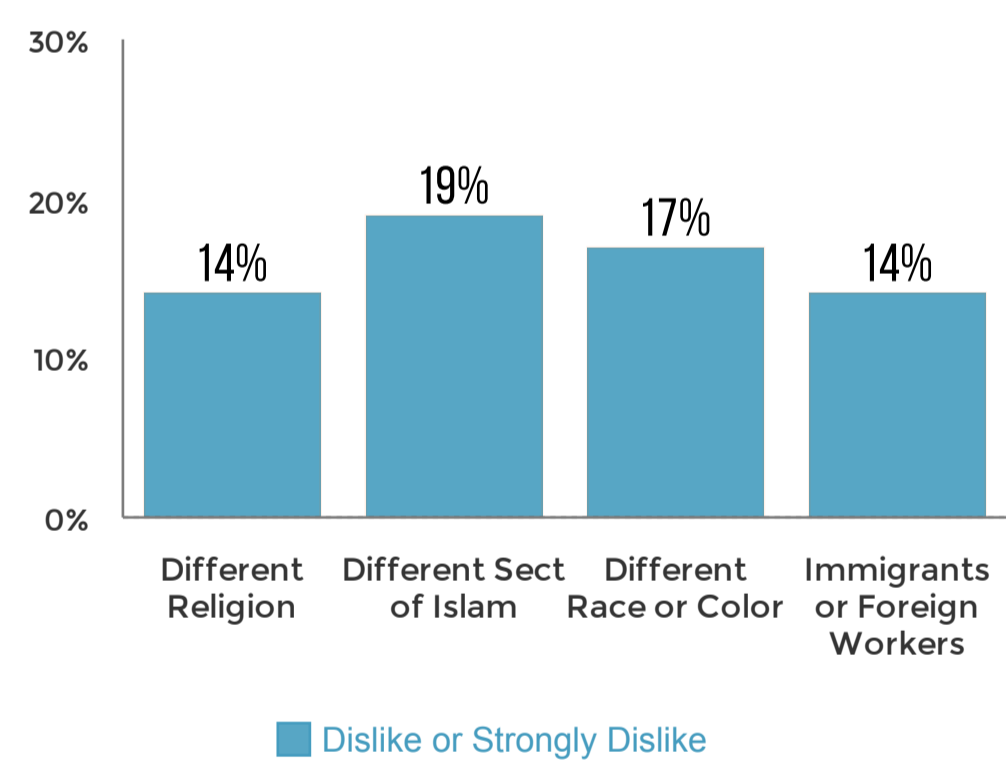
### Syrian Refugees in Jordan

## Who Is Worried About Harassment?

41% Syrian Refugees in Jordan

73% Syrian Refugees in Lebanon

79% (Women) 67% (Men)

Syrian Refugee Women in Lebanon are more likely to be worried about being harassed or threatened on the street.

There is no statistical difference about such situations between men and women in Jordan.
